



The Most Creative Man In The World, President Of International Academy Of Genius, Receives The George Washington Honor Medal For Saving Geniuses

While schools and school systems lose children to dropout epidemics, drugs, violence and crime, one man seems to know exactly what to do.

MONTGOMERY, Ala./EWORLDWIRE/Nov. 11, 2005 --- Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge, Pa., has selected Dr. Andrei Aleinikov as the 2005 recipient of the George Washington Honor Medal, the highest national award in the teacher/administrator category.

As Aaron Siegel, president and CEO of the Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge wrote, Dr. Aleinikov, president of International Academy of Genius, was selected for his "effort and accomplishments in waking up the genius in every child."

In one Singapore school, after less than three days of educational intervention, Aleinikov's Genius Education Methodology (GEM, already labeled "the GEM of Education" by media) saved 13 sixth graders who were selected by teachers as "doomed to fail" and "cannot be helped." Despite the teachers' predictions, all 13 children passed all the state exams (math, science, english and mother tongue). They had 52 chances to fail, but they failed none. Teachers called it a miracle; parents called it magic.

The award ceremony took place in The Club Atop Red Mountain in Birmingham, Al. at 11:30 a.m., Nov. 12, 2005.

Dr. Aleinikov is "the MegaCreativity Man" (as Dr. E. Paul Torrance called him), or "the world's leading expert on MegaCreativity," as Dr. K. Neethling, the founder of African Creativity Foundation, called him for his discovery of the human mind's ability to generate over 1,000,000 new ideas per minute.

Dr. Aleinikov's book entitled MegaCreativity: Five Steps to Thinking Like a Genius (Walking Stick Press, Cincinnati, 2002 also reprinted by John Wiley and Sons, Singapore, 2003) became a best seller in Asia. For the introduction of four new sciences, including Geniusology, the science of genius, Dr. Aleinikov was nominated for the nation's highest scientific honor - the President's National Medal of Science (NSF).

Aleinikov is gaining global recognition for his educational efforts. He originated the Genius Education Methodology (GEM) that earned him the 2003 Outstanding Educator Award for Innovative and Creative Teaching from the Academy of Educational Leadership, N.C., and also led to his Troy University nomination for the U.S. Professor of the Year Award (CASE).

As a Woodrow Wilson Visiting Fellow and a Guinness World Record holder, Dr. Aleinikov, whose mission is to create a nation of geniuses, inspires students, teaches teachers and trains employees of Fortune 500 companies. On 1995 he founded International Academy of Genius, a research and educational institution.
